FRENCH FOR KEY STAGE 1 (Reception, Year 1 and 2).

Here are some activities to interest you and help you keep learning French from home. Try to do a mix of activities rather than concentrating on one.

- 1. Download the app **Duolingo** and choose French as your language. This is fun and extremely popular across the world. It is for all ages. You can do it on a mobile, tablet or computer and it is free whilst on wifi.
- 2. **Busuu** is another app very similar to Duolingo. It is also fun, very popular and free. (Some aspects ask for payment, you do not need these aspects). You could do both Duolingo and Busuu if you enjoy them. To learn effectively you would need to do at least 10 minutes 3 times a week on one of them.
- 3. Listen to **French songs** whenever you can. They can play in the background in the house, play in the car and/or listen more attentively to a few favourites and try to sing along with them.

 You can try and pick up a French radio station or use Youtube or Spotify.

 (I am convinced that this is how people all around the world learn English so easily because English and American songs are played everywhere).
- 4. Watch and listen to 'French stories for children' and 'French videos for children'. BBC Bitesize has some good ones and Youtube has several.
- 5. If you already know the English alphabet 'off by heart' then try learning the **French alphabet**. There are several ways on Youtube. Then try playing 'Hangman' in French.
