Simile: Creating an image by comparing an object to something else.

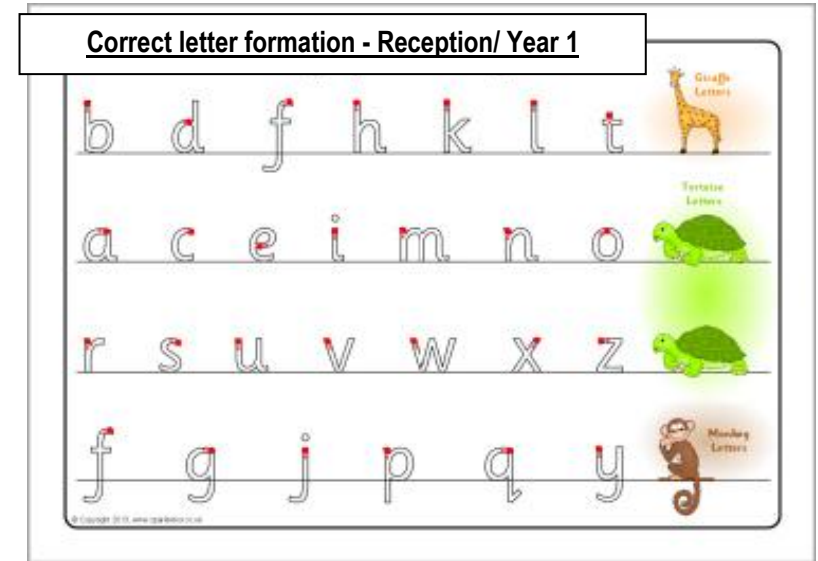
i.e. **As strong as an Ox. As happy as a lark.**
