Key vocabulary: memory, observation, imagination, line, colour, pattern, shape

Things to ask me: What does drawing from memory mean? What does drawing from observation mean? What does drawing from imagination mean?

Topic: The natural world around us

Key vocabulary: nature natural world explore observe touch smell hear care look after respect

Things to ask me: What have I noticed about world around me? How do I care for nature?

Physical Development

Topic: Functional skills

Key vocabulary: Movement, Space, Balance, Jump, Jog, Skip, Run, Hop, Side step, Heart, Lungs, Breathing

Things to ask me:

Can you show me 3 different ways to move around the space?
What happens to our heart beat when we take part in exercise?

Understanding the World: History & Geography

Topic: Harvest Festival



Key vocabulary: celebrate, Thankful, farming, food, harvesting, food bank

Things to ask me: How do people celebrate Harvest?
Why do people celebrate Harvest?

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Topic: All about me



Key vocabulary: Family, Parents, Grandparents, Sister, Brother, Cousins, Auntie, Uncle, different, same, safe

Things to ask me: Who is in my family?
How are families different? Who keeps me safe?

French



Topic: Colours and Numbers

Key vocabulary: Rouge-red, bleu-blue, vert-green, jaune-yellow, orange-orange, rose-pink, blanc-white, noir-black. 1-10 un, deux, trois, quatre, cinq, six, sept, huit, neuf, dix.

Things to ask me: How do I say 'Good morning and Good afternoon' in French?

Music

Topic: Express feelings and responses to music by talking about it and by moving and making a dance.

Key vocabulary: pulse (heartbeat of the music) and rhythm (long and short sounds)

Things to ask me: How would you move to this music?
How does it make you feel and why?
